

Hand Antibacterial Units In The Lido.

We strongly encourage all of our guests to assist us in retaining a healthy ship by using the hand antibacterial units before proceeding in to the buffet area. Dispensers are located at the entrances to the buffet area.

Credit or Debit Card Authorisation

During check-in you may have registered a credit or debit card to cover your onboard spending. An amount of \$100 has been held to cover any onboard spend, similar to what you would experience in hotels on land. During your time onboard we will run daily authorisations against your registered credit or debit card for any amounts exceeding the secured \$100. The authorised amounts are not taken from your account until it is finally settled on the day of disembarkation.

Change to our dress attire terminology.

Please be advised we have changed the language we use to describe the two types of evenings on board Cunard ships. Evenings that used to be termed 'Formal' are now described as 'Gala Evenings' and 'Informal' evenings are now described as requiring 'Smart Attire'. The actual dress attire requirements that relate to the two types of evening on board are not changing.
