⊙ TIME CHANGE

Please be reminded that early this morning the ship's time was SET BACK ONE HOUR. This will be repeated tomorrow and clocks will be SET BACK ONE HOUR early on Monday. Please set back your watches again before retiring this evening Sunday, 16, May.

NAVIGATION INFORMATION

The initial stages of our voyage across the Atlantic will have taken us from the Southern coast of England and out into the Celtic Sea. Additionally during this afternoon we will be crossing over the Maxwell Fracture Zone, which is a large undersea mountain range forming part of the mid Atlantic Ridge. Here, depths can shallow out to less than 1,000 metres before deepening again quickly to over 3,500 meters which is approximately 1.9 miles on the opposite side.

NAUTICAL FACT OF THE DAY

SON OF A GUN

A description given by the lower deck to children born on board ships of the British navy during the period when the wives of seamen were allowed to live on board in harbour and, occasionally, at sea. As the gangways had to be kept clear, the only place on board where women in labour could give birth was in the space in between the guns on the gun deck, so that, inevitably, any male child born on board was known as a 'son of a gun'. Such a birth gave rise to the saying: "Begotten in the galley and born under a gun. Every hair a ropeyarn, every tooth a marline spike, every finger a fish hook, and his blood right to good Stockholm tar".

Born and brought up in Brighton, Brian attended Brighton Technical College studying Mechanical Engineering. However, the family traditions have always been at sea and so Brian decided to seek a career at sea. Brian started a cadetship with British and Commonwealth Shipping Company, a group that included both Cargo and Passenger lines, the most notable being the Union Castle Line. Unfortunately, in 1977, Union Castle ships were taken out of service and Brian was given the opportunity to join Cunard on loan. After the initial contract on loan onboard the Cunard Princess Brian decided to join Cunard Line and has been with them over 27 years. After achieving both his second and first class certificates and serving for many years onboard the Cunard Princess and Countess he achieved his ambition of being promoted to Chief Engineer, a post he has held on board both vessels and subsequently on the Crown Dynasty, Sea Goddess 1 and QE2, before being given the opportunity to be Chief Engineer of Queen Mary 2. When not onboard Queen Mary 2, Brian spends the majority of his time in France.

Career highlights: Initially, the highlight of Brian's career was when he took over as Chief Engineer of Queen Elizabeth 2, although this was surpassed when he was asked to be part of the team standing by the building of Queen Mary 2 in France and subsequently be part of the team that successfully delivered Queen Mary 2.
